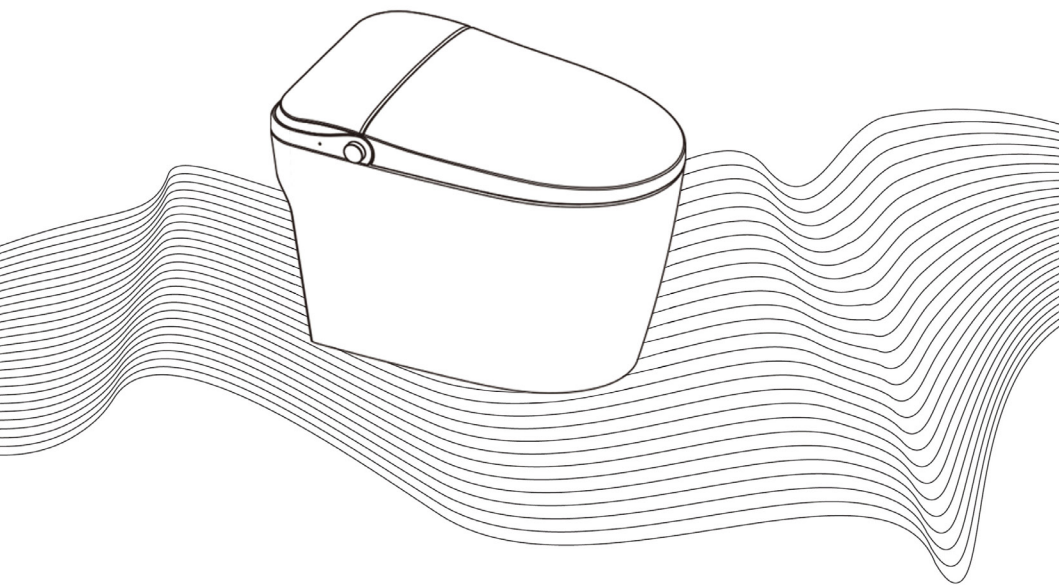

GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

This product should be grounded. In the event of an electrical short circuit, grounding reduces the risk of electric shock by providing an escape wire for the electric current. This product is equipped with a cord having a grounding wire with a grounding plug. This plug must be plugged into an outlet that is properly installed and grounded.



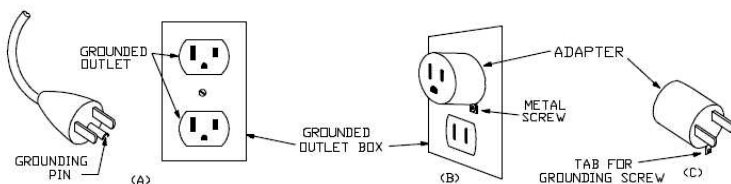
DANGER-Improper use of the grounding plug can result in a risk of electric shock

If repair or replacement of the cord or plug is necessary, do not connect the grounding wire to either flat blade terminal. The wire with insulation having an outer surface that is green with or without yellow stripes is the grounding wire.

Check with a qualified electrician or serviceman if the grounding instructions are not completely understood, or if in doubt as to whether the product is properly grounded.

This product is for use on a nominal 110 V circuit, and has a grounding plug that looks like the plug illustrated in sketch A in below Grounding methods. A temporary adapter, which looks like the adapter illustrated in sketches B and C, may be used to connect this plug to a 2-pole receptacle as shown in sketch B if a properly grounded outlet is not available. The temporary adapter should be used only until a properly grounded outlet (sketch A) can be installed by a qualified electrician. The green colored rigid ear, lug, and the like extending from the adapter must be connected to a permanent ground such as a properly grounded outlet box cover. Whenever the adapter is used, it must be held in place by the screw.

This is an electrical product, so please do not install it in a place where it is easily get wet by water or in a high humidity. When using it in the bathroom, please install a ventilator or vent to ensure good air circulation in the bathroom.

Please set the socket for power wiring as follows.

The lists below are the following requirement to avoid fire or electric shock.

- Use a high-sensitivity, fast-type leakage switch (rated induction current below 15mA) or an insulated transformer (above 1.5KVA and below 3KVA) for protection.
- The installation position of the socket must be more than 0.3m above the ground, and as far as possible from the bathtub.



This product needs to be properly earthed.

If it is not earthed, it may cause electric shock.

Note: The earthing treatment mentioned here refers to the earthing resistance below 100Ω, and the grounding wire of the switchboard uses a copper wire with a diameter of 1.6mm or more.

Please confirm that the power plug is waterproofed with Silica Gel.

Before you Install

Confirm dimensions of product with installation space

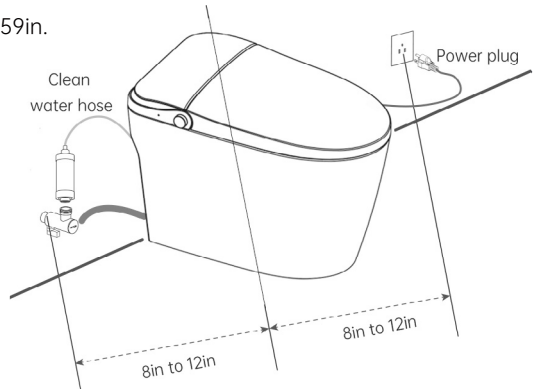


1. Confirm dimensions of product with installation space.
2. Check your installation conditions. (water supply, water pressure, electrical circuit)
3. Pay attention to other objects.
 - Other objects (door, cabinet, etc) may affect the installation or sensing functions.

Confirm dimensions of power plug and water hose

The length of the power cord is 59in.
Make sure the power supply is within reach.

The length of the clean water hose is 31.49in.
The length of the flush water hose is 23.6in.
Make sure the water outlet is within reach.

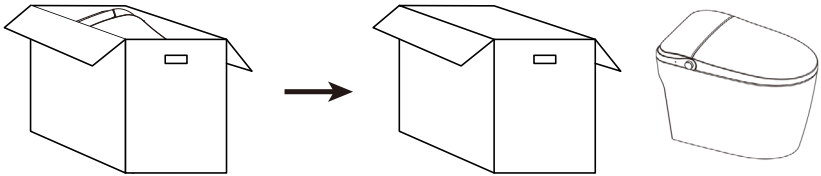


Installing

Install your unit using the following steps.

1 Open the box right side up

Remove the accessories first, then remove the unit from the top, as shown in the diagrams below.

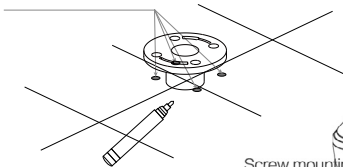


2 Mark your drainage hole with a cross

1. Align the flange with the drain hole, and mark the positions of the four mounting holes of the flange on the ground with a marking pen.

2. Place the toilet on the ground with aligning the ground drain hole, place two fixing blocks in the openings on the left and right sides of the toilet bottom, mark the screw mounting hole positions of the fixing block with a marking pen, and then remove the toilet.

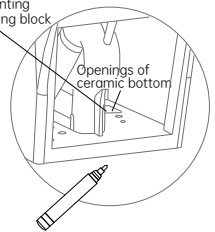

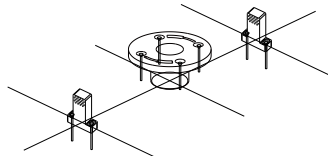
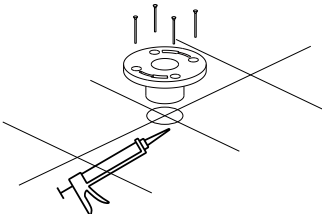

3 1. Put the flange on the drain hole, and fix it on the ground with four bolts. Then Seal the flange with glass glue.

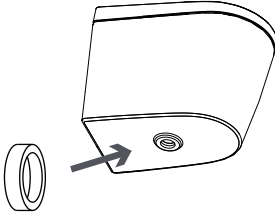
2. Place the fixing block on the installation position marked by the line drawing pen and fasten it with two bolts.



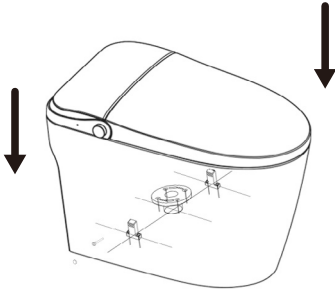

4 Install the ceramic body, water supply hose, T-valve

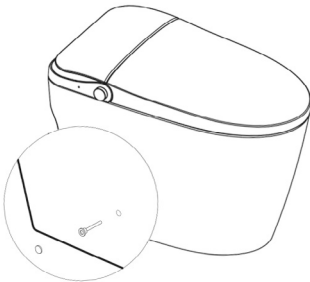
1. Place the wax ring on the drain hole at the bottom of the ceramic.



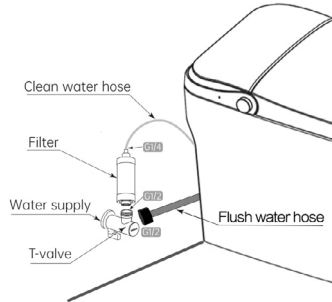
2. Align the ceramic drain with the drain hole on the ground, and press down to make the wax ring fully contact with the ground.



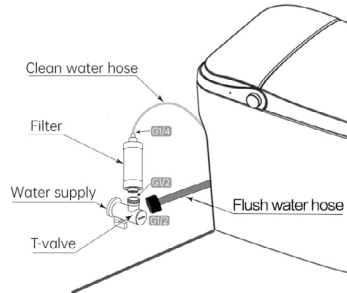
3. Fix the two sides of the ceramic with two bolts, and finally install the cap.



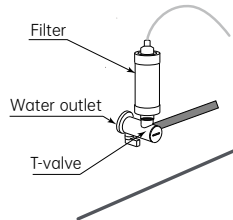
4. Attach the flush water hose to the T-valve and tighten.



5. Attach the filter and clean water hose to the T-valve and tighten.



6. Open the main valve to empty sewage, until clear. Connect the T-valve to the water supply and tighten. Use gasket to prevent water leakage.



7. Finish installation.

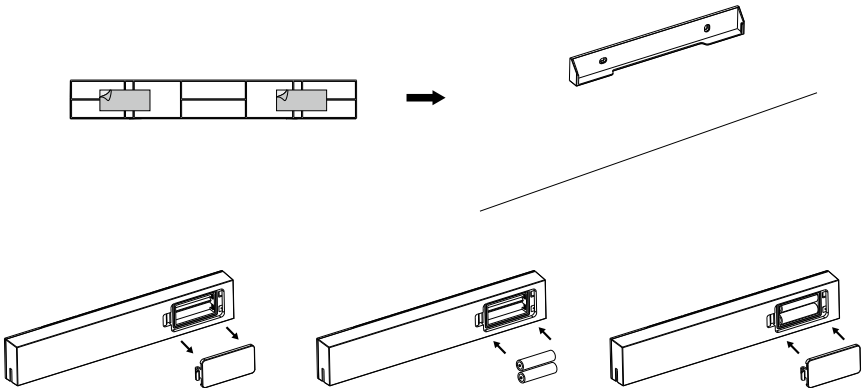
Installing

5 Installing the remote

1. Tear off the adhesive film behind the remote control holder.
2. Secure the holder to the wall.
3. Remove the battery cover from the backside of the remote to install batteries.
4. Pair the remote control with the toilet
5. Once finished, remote is ready to be placed in its holder.

Detailed steps shown in the diagram below:

- The remote control holder should be installed away from the bidet's spray trajectory.
- The remote control holder should be installed within reach when seated on unit.
- Make sure there is nothing to block the transmission between the toilet and its remote.

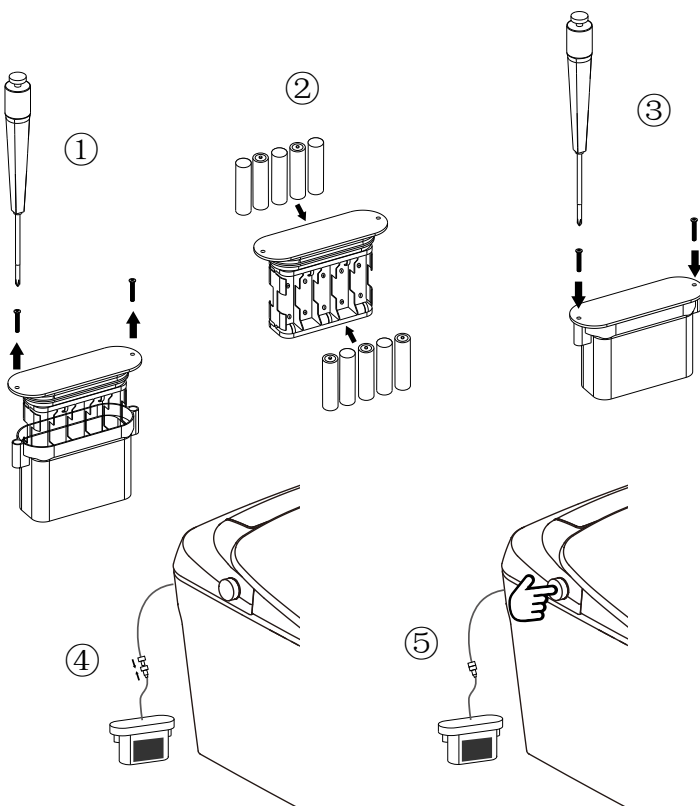

6 Installing and using the battery box

- 1.Remove the battery cover by unscrewing the screw with acrosshead screwdriver;
- 2.Add the new battery, shut the battery cover, and tighten the screw with a crosshead screwdriver;
- 3.Only connect the battery to the connecting wire during power outages;
- 4.Press the knob on the side of the toilet to flush

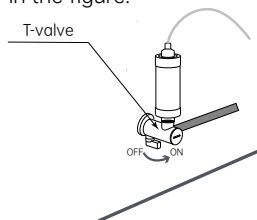
- Please confirm the battery's positive and negative poles.
- Please do not charge, disassemble, fire the battery, or mix with used batteries or different kinds of batteries to avoid liquid leakage or explosion.
- The battery box has a moisture-proof function. Please ensure that the set screws are screwed in place to achieve a good seal effect.
- **Connecting the battery during normal power supply may cause the toilet to be unusable.**



Installing

7 Testing water flow

1. Open the T-valve to maximum as shown in the figure.

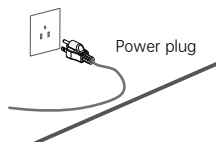


2. Confirm various connecting parts are not waterleaking

- In case of water leaking, unfasten the nuts again and install them again.

8 Connecting power

1. Connect to the grounding.
2. Plug in AC 110V power plug.



3. Check to see if the power is on.

- (1) Check to see if the power light is on.
If not, push the reset button.

- (2) Once the power light is on, the toilet will run its initial diagnostic: lights will turn on, cleaning nozzle will extend, the motor will begin to run and water will run through the system.

9 Remote control pairing

When the product leaves the factory, the remote control and the product are connected, if the remote control went failure, please re-connect the code as following methods.

TEST

Push the **TEST** button on the plug to shut off power supply

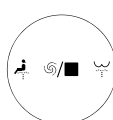

RESET

Push the **RESET** button on the plug to turn on the smart toilet, wait till you hear "Di"

③



Then you turn the knob switch counterclockwise for 3-5 seconds, when you hear "Di", quickly press any button on the remote control for pairing.

10 Testing the product (Checking the side knob and remote control)

1. Are all the functions working properly?

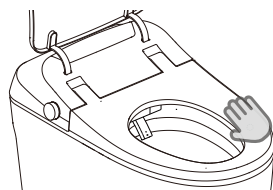
Posterior Wash, Front Wash (Including water pressure & nozzle position adjustment), Heated Dryer, Water & Seat temperature Adjustment, Nozzle cleaning, remote control.

All functions listed above should be tested.

2. Checking posterior wash

Place hand on sensor point (shown in illustration on right), Activate the posterior function on the side knob or the wireless remote.

Use hand to block nozzle spray.



Remote control instructions



How to use the remote control



Full Flush

Press this button to flush.



Half Flush

Press this button to flush with a smaller amount of water.



Hip

Press this button when you are seated, the rear wash cleaning nozzle will spray for 2 minutes, during this time, press the button again to start or stop the oscillate, and then stop spraying automatically.



Female

Press this button when you are seated, the front wash cleaning nozzle for female will spray for 2 minutes, during this time, press the button again to start or stop the oscillate, and then stop spraying automatically.



Dryer

Press this button to start drying when you are seated. During this time, press the button again to start or stop the oscillate, warm air drying will stop automatically after 4 minutes.



Child

Press this button to start child's wash with lower temperature and lower water pressure. Security measures: not adjustable for all cleansing parameters.



Cover

Press this button to open/close the lid.



Seat

Press this button to open/close the seat ring.



Water Temp

4 degrees can adjust the water temperature when washing.

The temperature can be set as:
Environment Temp., 95°F, 99°F, 103°F



ECO

Turn on or off the ECO (Economical) mode, which is for saving energy of turning off the heated seat.

Remote control instructions



Seat Temp

4 degrees can adjust the seat temperature.

The tempature can be set as:

Environment Temp., 95°F, 99°F, 103°F



Massage

Turn on/off the automatic water or pressure big and small alternatively for creating a water massage feeling



Air Temp

4 degrees can adjust the air temperature when drying.

The temperature can be set as:

The environment temp., 113°F, 122°F, 131°F



Auto Temp

Turn on or off the automatic temperature adjustment mode which automatically adjusts three temperatures according to the environment



Light

The night light can be turned on or off in the power-on state.



Sterilization

Press this button to open/close the UV sterilization for 30s after closing the cover



Stop

Under the washing mode and drying mode, press it for short time to stop the running function.



Cleaning position

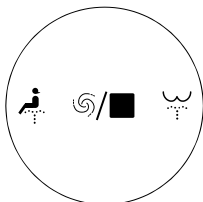
4 positions can be chosen when washing.



Cleaning pressure

4 water pressure can be chosen when washing.

Side Button instructions



Flush/Stop function

Long-press the knob while seated to activate warm air drying.

Long-press the knob when not seated to turn the unit off.

Female wash/Moving function

Rotate the knob counterclockwise to activate the female wash.

Rotate it again to activate the moving wash function.

Hip wash/Moving function

Rotate the knob clockwise to activate hip wash.

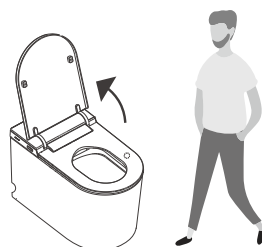
Rotate it again to activate the moving wash function.

Special Function Description

Auto Open&Close

if a person approaches the induction location , the seat cover will automatically open. When people leaves the body sensor area for 2 mins, the seat cover will automatically close.

- Press the "**Hip**" button on remote control for 5 seconds to turn it on or off.



Auto Pre-wetting

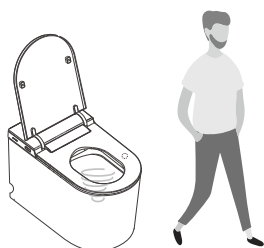
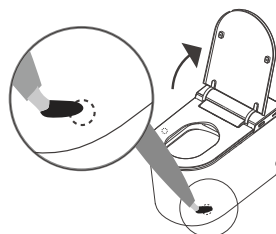
Once the seat sensor detects a user, it will release a small amount of water to moisten the ceramic inner wall, thus preventing adhesion.

- Press the "**Water Temp**" button on remote control for 5 seconds to turn it on or off.

Foot Sensor

When the right foot is close to the foot sensor, the toilet will open the seat cover / open the seat ring. / close the cover and flush

- Press the "**Ring**" button on remote control for 5 seconds to turn it on or off.



Auto Flush

When the seat sensor no longer (10s) detects a user, it will automatically flush once .

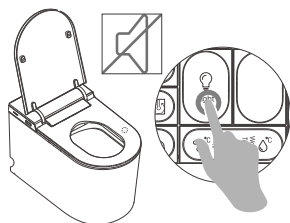
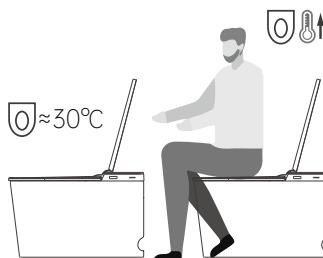
- Press the "**Strong Flush**" button on remote control for 5 seconds to turn it on or off

Special Function Description

Energy-efficient mode

When the seat temperature is set to 35°C/37°C/39°C:
The seat maintains a temperature of approximately 30°C when unoccupied, and warms up to the set level only when a user is seated.

- Press and hold **"Light"** button on remote control for 5 seconds to turn it on or off



Silent mode

When the remote control is pressed, the toilet will no longer make feedback sounds to keep silent at night.

- Press the **"Dryer"** button on remote control for 5 seconds to turn it on or off.

Maintenance

Regular maintenance is required to ensure normal use

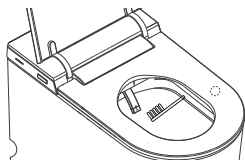
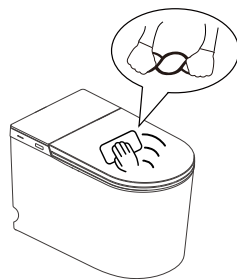


Electric
Product

- Be careful not to let water seep inside or leave detergent in the gap between the top unit and bowl unit. (May damage plastic parts or cause a malfunction.)
- Keep the Seat Sensing Area clean, never cover it with seat sheath or other things.
- Cut off the power and water supply before maintenance.
- Direct water wash to entire product is prohibited.

Maintenance of product surface and ceramics

- Unplug the power plug from the outlet before cleaning.
- Wipe with a soft cloth that has been soaked in water and wrung-out thoroughly.
- For heavy dirt: Wipe with a soft cloth soaked in diluted, neutral kitchen detergent, and then wipe with a soft cloth soaked in water.
- Wipe off any cleaner that remains on the product.
- Wipe off all water that remains on the product to prevent water seep inside.
- For cleaning or maintenance of plastic parts, do not use any harsh cleaning agents. (These include, but are not limited to products such as: concentrated sulfuric acid, concentrated nitric acid, glacial acetic acid, carbon tetrachloride, chloroform, acetone, butanone, benzene, methylbenzene, phenol, methylphenol, dimethylformamide, methyl ether, soybean oil, acetate, 40% nitric acid, thick salt acid, 95% alcohol, gasoline, kerosene or brake oil, etc).



Maintenance of nozzle

1. When unseated, press Nozzle Self-Cleaning button on the Remote Control.
Enter "Nozzle Self-Cleaning", the nozzle extends and water sprays out for cleaning.
2. Wipe with a soft toothbrush.
 - Do not pull, push or press the nozzle with excessive force.
 - Do not use any acid detergent.
3. Press Stop button to finish
 - The nozzle retracts.

Others

- To prevent breaking, please empty water from the tank when not using the product for a long time.
- Before connecting the product to the water supply and electrical outlet, allow it to defrost for 30 mins in a warm indoor environment.
- In case of freezing, unable to flush or wash, the cloth soaked in hot water can be covered on the water supply hose of the toilet or the connection part of the water supply hose to defrost it. (Do not pour hot water or blow hot air with high temperature on the product body, water supply hose and other objects).
- The shutoff valve should be cleaned every 6 months.

The air is not warm	Air temp set too low	Set air temperature to proper level

Symptoms	Possible Causes	Please check
Wash mode is abnormal	Not yet seated or current sitting posture unable to be sensed by the seat	Seated or adjust your sitting gesture
	Tee valve for water supply is closed or not opened completely	Fully open the tee valve for water supply
	Insufficient water pressure	Check bend problem on inlet hose, if so, adjust hose
The wash mode stops in the middle of use	Wash mode stops automatically after continuous flushing for 120s	If necessary, turn on the wash mode again
	The seat is unable to sense human body	Adjust your sitting gesture or sit on the toilet again
The water is not warm	Water temp set too low	Water air temperature to proper level

	Angle valve for water supply is closed	Open the angle valve for water supply
	Auto-flushing is deactivated	Press and hold "FLUSH" button at the remote control
When the water pressure is normal, but can't be washed and flush.	Sewage is leaking	Ask a professional to perform maintenance
	The sewage pipe is clogged	Please purchase a plug in the local market for dredging

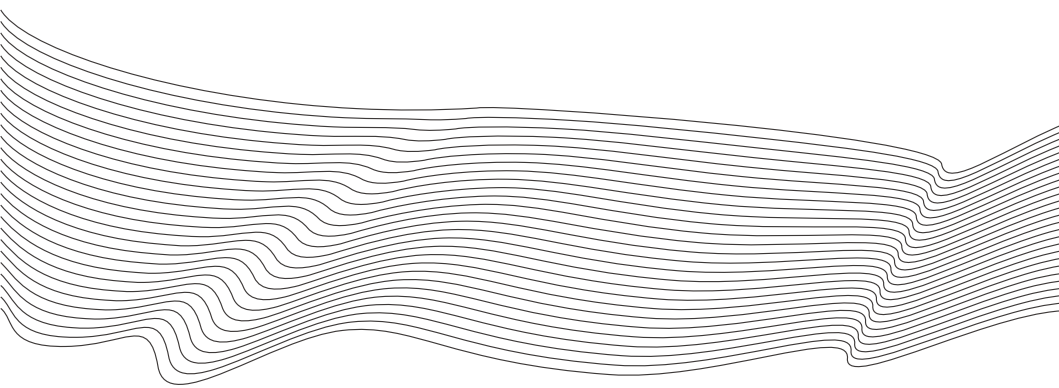
